- **Knowledge**

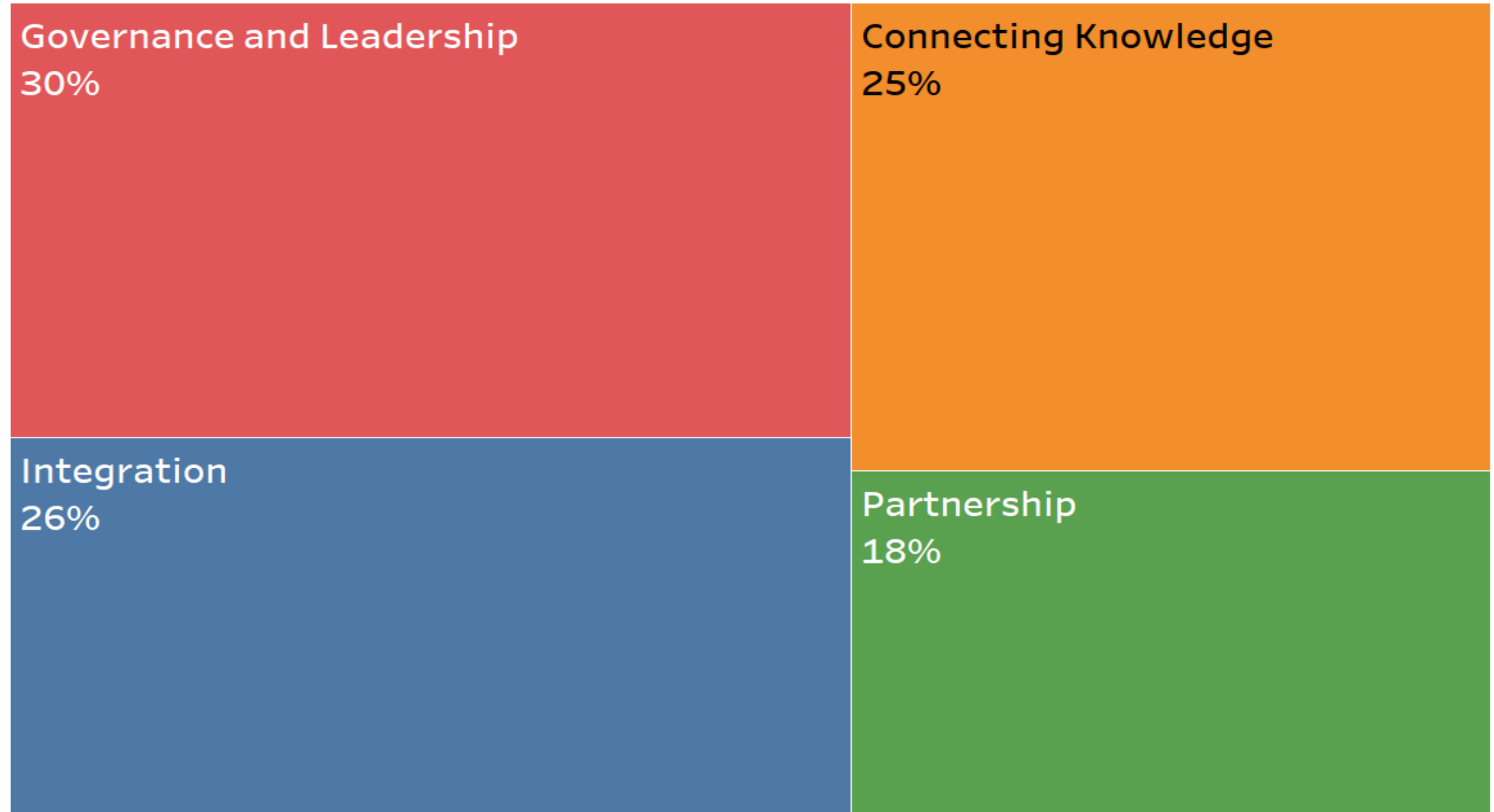

IAPB Africa will now follow up with members to define and agree on roles and action points for the committed activities.

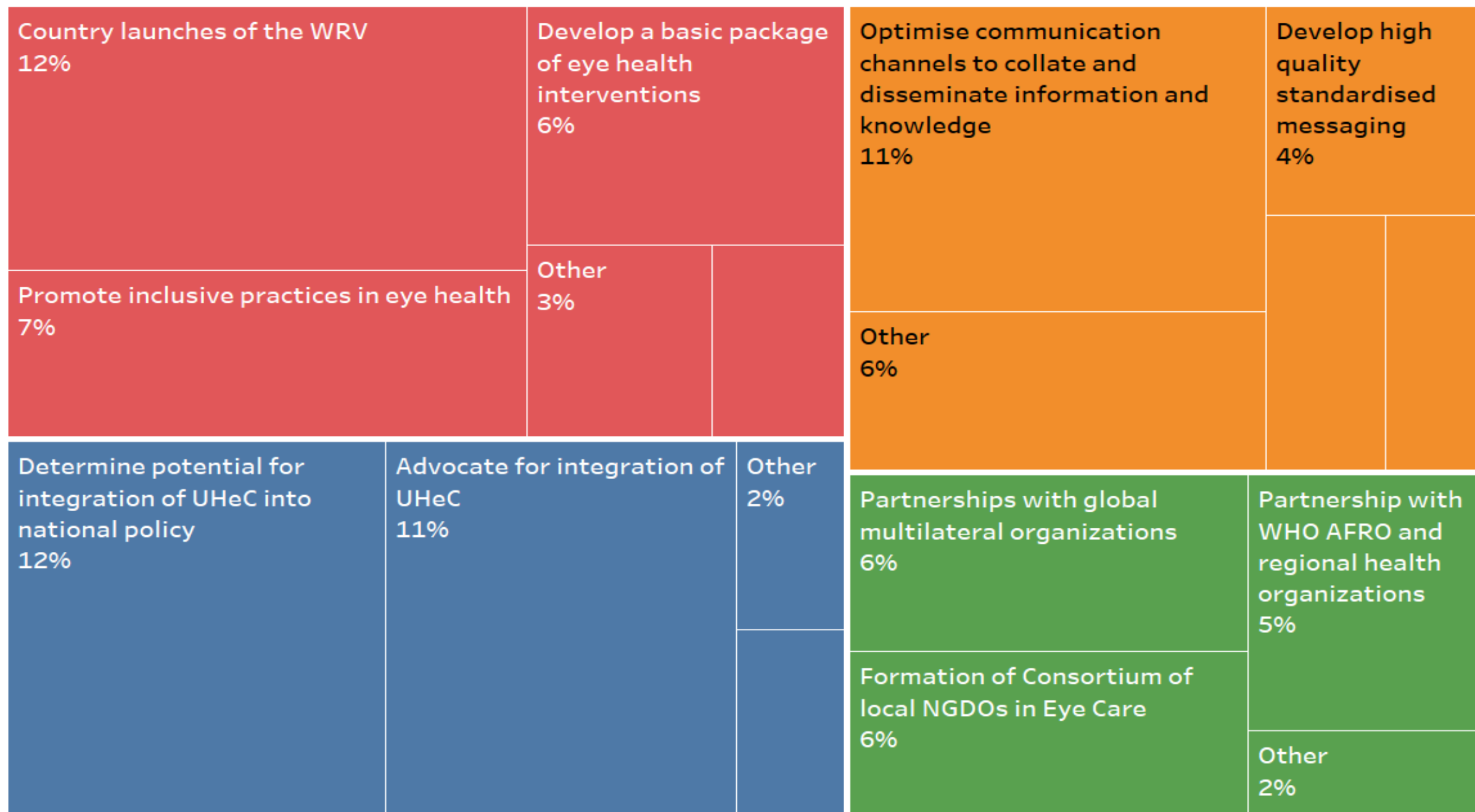

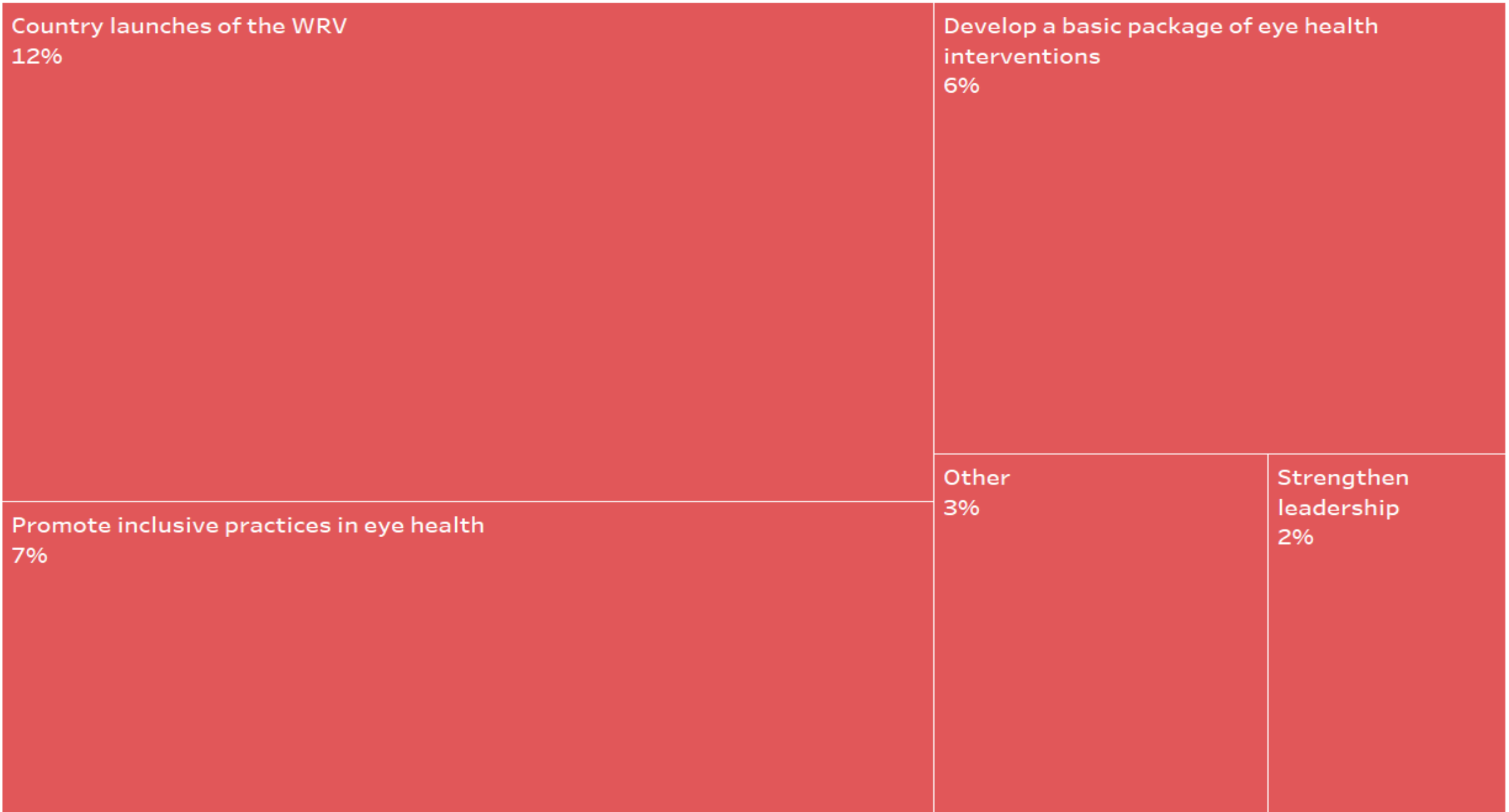

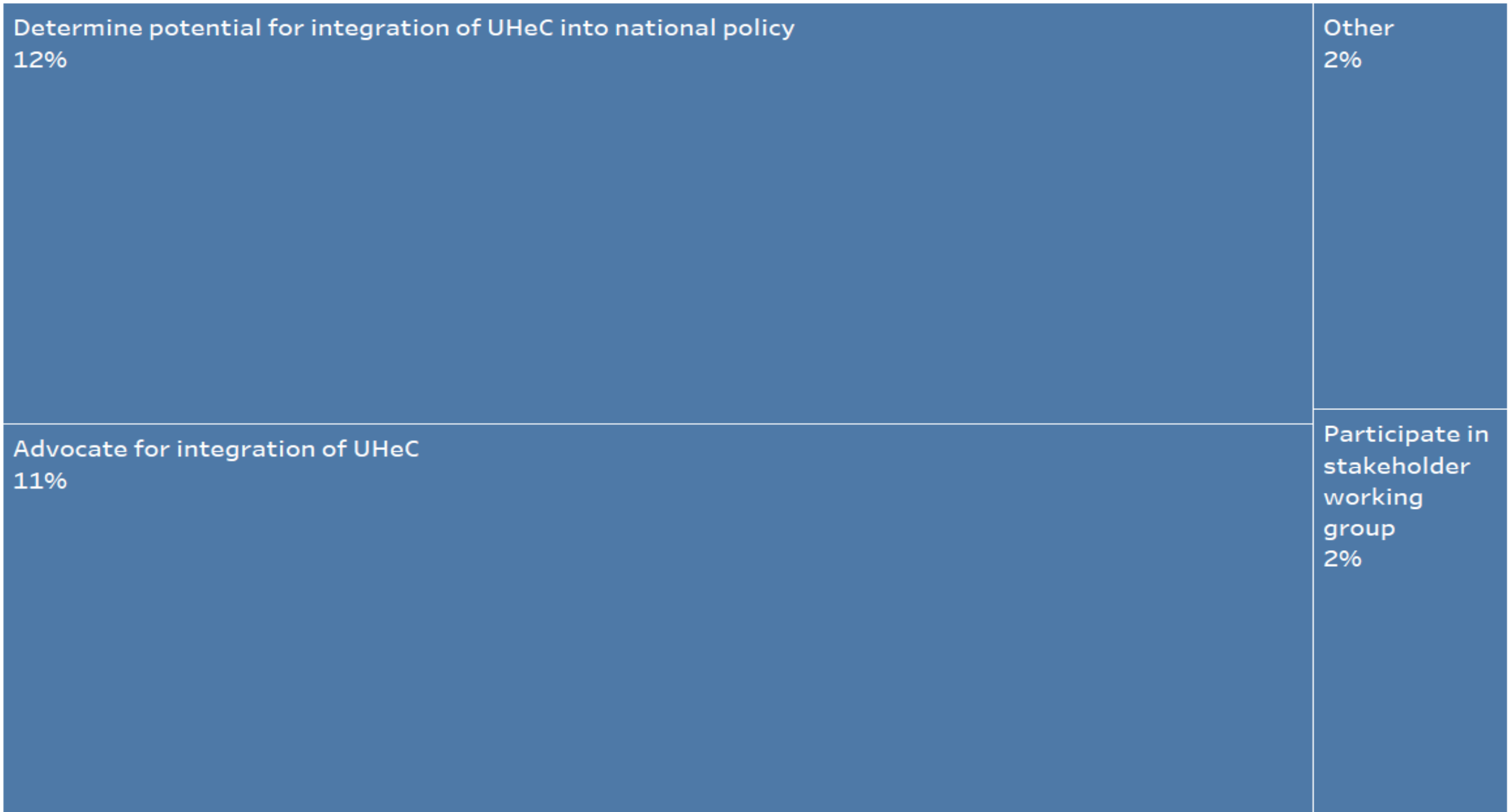
