evaluated against 9 Factors for Success

Top factors preventing effective cornea transplants in China

1) Legal framework

- Lack of favorable regulatory policy
- Strict policy on importing corneas

2) Access to donor population

- Cultural & religious barriers
- Distrust


3) Commitment to donation (awareness)

Passive vs proactive approach

4) Financial sustainability

• Insufficient reimbursement for eye banks, surgeons, and patients

- Testing approach to families for consent to donation
- Research:
 - Transplant success rate
 - Attitudes towards donation
 - Surgeon capacity
- Eye bank development

2) 角膜捐献人群的可及性


- 文化及宗教信仰的差异
- 缺乏信任


3) 角膜捐献意愿
