During the screenings and outreach activities we encourage you to capture stories of the patients you meet. We would love to know how your efforts are impacting the people your programmes benefit.

## TIPS FOR A GREAT IMPACT STORY

Seek the stories of people who have never had their vision checked before.

Seek the stories of people who have a condition that can be treated, and their quality-of-life will improve as a result.

Get a quote from a beneficiary you have met about poor vision has impacted their life.

Get a quote from a beneficiary you have met about how good vision has impacted their life.

Ask details about their work and how clear vision will help them perform their duties.

Capture a photo of your subject, smiling, bright images are usually best.

Always ask for approval to use their image, quote or name.
