Focus: systems, sustainability, policy change

Likely supporters: ministries of health, multilateral agencies

Vision C: Empower communities to demand quality, culturally appropriate eye care services.

Focus: equity, participation, bottom-up change

Likely supporters: civil society, local leaders, rights-based organisations
